It is sad to report that two of our Brother Knights have been called to their eternal resting places:

Brother Bill Raddatz, a 4th Degree Knight died Saturday morning 27 Feb 2010 at the Hospice Care Center at McKee Medical Center in Loveland. His funeral and Mass of Christian burial is scheduled for 11:00 AM Thursday, March 4th at St. Joseph Catholic Church. Brother Bill Raddatz joined the Knights of Columbus in June 1944 and became a 4th degree in May 1947. He was our senior 4th degree member.



Brother James Deeds was diagnosed three weeks ago with a recurrence of leukemia for the third time, and was being treated for it, as well as for a viral infection and a bacterial infection. The combination of the three issues, along with his weakened state from the chemotherapy and radiation turned out to be too much for his body to take. He died Thursday Feb. 25th at about 10:30 AM. As Council 1214's Recorder, I, Duane Alan Rothers was born in Denver on 28 August 1966. Jerry suggested it was a good way to meet new people and do some good works, so I decided to join and have been glad I did. The Knights to Christ book has been a good way for me to be reminded to reflect on my faith and keep it at the front on my mind. I also enjoy working at the Mission. Mostly I enjoy the brotherhood of being with my fellow Knights. The first activity I attended after joining the Knights was the Valentine's Day Dance. This was before I had even attended a regular meeting or worked a single Bingo session. I remember what a good time we had and how we were welcomed by everyone. The first person I remember talking to was Doug Wree, who of course had a joke to share. It was really a fun evening and we got a good idea of what a good group of people the Knights and their families were. My hobbies include a new garden we started last year, tropical fish and reading.
