I, Mark Coleman, Past Grand Knight and District Deputy, was born in St. Louis, MO on December 25, 1954. I have an older brother who is also an engineer and lives in San Diego. My parents, Ollie and Lee moved from Branson, MO to Fort Collins in 2006 and are also members of St. Joseph. They are always at 7:00 AM Mass on Sundays and Dad attends daily Mass. My Wife, Jeanette is a great RCIA instructor and is the Pastor's assistant at St. Joseph's. My two daughters Crystal and Nicole also live in Fort Collins and we have 4 grandchildren: Drake, Alycia, Brittny and Mackenzie. I graduated from Purdue, IN, and one of my favorite traditions is watching the Indy 500 every Memorial Day and listening to Gomer Pyle (Jim Nabors) sing, "Back Home Again in Indiana". After graduation I took a job at HP in Loveland/Fort Collins where I have remained for 34 years. During that time I have held a number of positions which some folks would call "nerdy". HP has undergone enormous change since 1977. At that time HP was noted for designing electrical test equipment. But in 1977 HP introduced a predecessor of the first PC and by 2010 had become the number one manufacturer of Computing Equipment in the world. When I came from the Midwest to Loveland on April 26, 1977 I was driving a 1963 Plymouth Valiant station wagon which I inherited from my mother's father. Oh wait a minute; I'm still driving that car . . . okay some things never change. ☺ I suppose I would like to be remembered for my commitment and faithfulness. To that end I wear three rings reminding me of three lifetime commitments:

- a graduation ring as a sign of Catholic education and a commitment to the Church
- a stainless steel ring as a sign of the obligation and responsibility of the Engineer
- a wedding band as a sign of the commitment of Marriage

On of my favorite memories is Jeanette and I spending many days fishing from my Mom and Dad's 15' Ranger Bass boat. Our most favorite memories are from Lake Taneycomo and especially Bull Creek, just above Rockaway Beach on the left bank. On a hot summer day the sunlight filters through the sycamores and dogwoods. The water is cool, deep and green. And the reflection of the enormous trees lining the banks is hypnotizing. The aging boat eases along silently; under power of a trolling motor. Great Blue Heron patrol the shoreline in search of an easy meal, noisy King Fishers swoop between the low hanging limbs and an occasional Bald Eagle soars over head. The boat rocks gently and the old stuffed boat chairs are amazingly comfortable. It would be easy to fall asleep if not for the pesky Blue Gill and Bass constantly interrupting our serenity. My Grandfather and Uncles were Knights at Council 1230 in Festus, MO. As a boy I attended many weddings and funeral dinners at the Festus K of C hall. So when Jim Kasal asked me to join the Knights in 1986, how could I say no? The Past Grand Knights Picnic, State Conventions and the National Convention have always been influential to me. These events inspire me as a testament to Fr. McGivney's founding principles and they serve as a reminder of the Knights' noble history and long standing traditions. I remember the great time we had moving Bernard Sheahan out of his old house on Juniper Court one Saturday back in the 1990's. It was more work than anyone had planned and we were glad to be done. A couple of months later Paul Pellegrino asked us to help move his brother out of a house which Paul was moving into and when we showed up to start the day's activities, it turned out to be that same house. I remember how quickly the Knights moved Jeanette and I into our current home one Saturday morning. The entire move took about 4 hours with nearly 20 guys working feverishly. It has always amazed me how much work can be accomplished by a motivated and well-organized team.

**Strong Start for Culture of Life Campaign**

Thanks to all the Knights, Parishioners, and other friends who have helped get the KofC 1214 Culture of Life Campaign off to a roaring start. Through this campaign, we will help build a culture that respects life in all its stages, by sharing God's love for life through positive and prayerful initiatives. We kicked off the campaign at our April 15 Lenten Fish Dinner, setting a goal of raising \$4000 in the first year. So far we are on track to meet this goal. The fish dinner raised \$1200, and since then we have received an additional \$2600 in donations!

In June we succeeded in putting some of these funds to work promoting the local Birthmothers pregnancy crisis program in our community. Paid ads are now up in the women's restrooms of 10 Fort Collins venues to reach out to women in trouble. Also, our billboard promoting Birthmothers went up in Fort Collins, watch for it as you drive west on Riverside Avenue approaching Mulberry Street. In July we will further invest in the culture of life with a \$500 donation to the Colorado Knights of Columbus Ultrasound Initiative, which funds new ultrasound machines for pro-life clinics.
